- Currently have a confidentiality agreement form upon entering intergroup office, but there wasn't a policy/ enforcement that accompanied it (some people signed, some people didn't)
 - Looking at formalizing a policy for count of who has codes

- Detox and "les maisons" halfway house going well
- Will be at Eastern Ontario conference next weekend (Oct 17-18)
- Question from floor: what level of service does detox report from?
 - They are a committee of district 54

Old Business

Information on proposals for use of excess funds

- Proposed evaluation criteria See below
- Reminder that this surplus is not routine/ on-going. The board suggests it be used for one-time projects
- If the proposal deadline is extended to the end of October, the board will not review until November, so the members vote will likely not happen until December
- Criteria are needed to establish a professional common headspace



- Affordability touches both the financial and human resources needed (who will put in the effort needed to head the proposed project)
- Per our bylaws, Intergroup's primary purpose is to "Provide services for AA groups"
- The plain language Big Book is a good place for clarification on the 12 concepts

Discussion from floor

- 1. Have we ever been in a position where we couldn't maintain our prudent reserve? If we spend his excess, will we potentially be at risk?
 - Previous Intergroup treasurers have to New York World Services. It was deemed that our reserve is acceptable for our needs. (It has been higher)
 - There will be initiatives that "lose" money, but is for the greater good of AA/ alcoholics
- 2. Suggest that we **do** look at operational items to avoid accumulating another surplus.
 - Any on-going projects can be <u>new</u> motions brought to an intergroup meeting, They should not be in the scope of spending this one-time surplus
- 3. Understanding that the proposals are for the surplus, there is a question as to how such an excess amount was amassed
 - Reminder that Intergroup was recently bequeathed a significant amount in someone's will, which makes up a good portion of the surplus

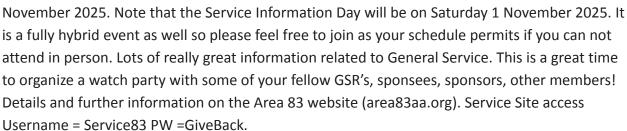
